## **Volunteer Opportunities for you.....**

**Flower and Bulletin Sponsors for 2024**—The 2024 sign-up register is now in the church office on the desk if you want to reserve a date for the coming year. Ushers & Head Ushers, Greeters and Scripture Readers are needed for our worship service each week. Both ladies and gentlemen are welcome to participate and new faces are always welcome. There are sign-up sheets on the table at the rear of the sanctuary where you can sign up for any of these. Please consider helping out with these portions of our service so that our program is complete. Thank you.

Card Ministry — our visitation team has placed some cards in a box on the table at the rear of the sanctuary which you are encouraged to add a brief note in and sign for our shut-ins. St. Paul's will then put postage on these and mail them to brighten up their day between visits by our Pastor and the Visitation Team. **An added feature to our website** — under the Online Giving category, a "miscellaneous" option has been added. **Dumpster Update-** our waste hauler, Republic Services, was approached about repositioning our dumpster in another direction so that if cars are parked there, we did not have to worry about their truck getting to it. They agreed and the unit has been turned towards N. Charles St. This enables their truck to come in the alley off of N. Charles and access the dumpster from there without coming in from the parking lot side, making things easier for everybody all around.

**An update on the Upper Room devotionals** — Now that we have received a quantity of a 90-day Introductory Edition of Our Daily Bread devotional for your use, and have set up a subscription with them, The Upper Room has responded back to us in a letter that they are going to resume our subscription with them. They said some glitch in their ordering system was at fault that deleted their automatic shipments to existing customers. So, before too long, we should have both the Daily Bread <u>and</u> The Upper Room devotionals here. Please let the church office know which one you prefer, or if you want to have both available to choose from. Thank you for your patience on this delay and "glitch".

Also, please let the church office know if you have a family member that would like a visit from St. Paul's Pastor or the Visitation Team and we will see that info is passed along. Thank you.

**The Congregational Meeting held last Sunday** — there were 36 voting members that attended. Of those, 28 voted for approving the By Laws as presented, 2 voted against approval, and 6 abstained. Using our stipulated 2/3 majority benchmark (which would require at least 24 approving), the motion passed. We now have a workable document to administer our church with, but this is a fluid document that will continue to need to adapt to our needs and requirements as we change as a church. We thank all who worked on this document for their time and efforts in putting it all together.
