

Volunteer Opportunities for you.....

Flower and Bulletin Sponsors—The sign-up register is in the church office on the desk if you want to reserve a date for the balance of the year. Ushers & Head Ushers, Greeters and Scripture Readers are needed for our worship service each week. Both ladies and gentlemen are welcome to participate and new faces are always welcome. There are sign-up sheets on the table at the rear of the sanctuary where you can sign up for any of these. Please consider helping out with these portions of our service so that our program is complete. Thank you.

Card Ministry – our visitation team continues to place some cards in a box on the table at the rear of the sanctuary which you are encouraged to add a brief note in and sign for our shut-ins. St. Paul's will then put postage on these and mail them to brighten up their day between visits by our Pastor and the Visitation Team. Joni Horne and Mary Loyer have volunteered for this team. *Also, please let the church office know if you have a family member that would like a visit from St. Paul's Pastor or the Visitation Team* and we will see that info is passed along. Thank you.

A Need in Our Community – Grace Lutheran Church, Red Lion has been doing a food and clothing outreach ministry at their location since the 1980's. They are currently serving nearly 130 families quarterly. Unfortunately, they have not had a permanent set up, requiring it be set up and taken down each time. They are converting two classrooms next to their social hall into a permanent "store" for this purpose where all the items can be accessible at all times for their clients, rather than having to set up/tear down each time. They are in need of monetary donations to purchase heavy-duty rolling clothing racks, wall shelf units, shelving and other fixtures to get this up and running by fall of this year. Their goal is to raise at least \$3,000.00 for this initial start-up. Any donations over \$250 will have an acknowledgement and thank you displayed within the store.
